Reto Knutti is a climate physicist and full professor of climate physics at ETH Zurich. He earned his Ph.D. in physics in 2002 and spent several years as a postdoctoral fellow and visiting researcher at the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) in Boulder, Colorado, before joining ETH Zurich as a professor in 2007. Prof. Dr. Reto Knutti's research focuses on the global climate system, particularly on changes caused by anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions.
